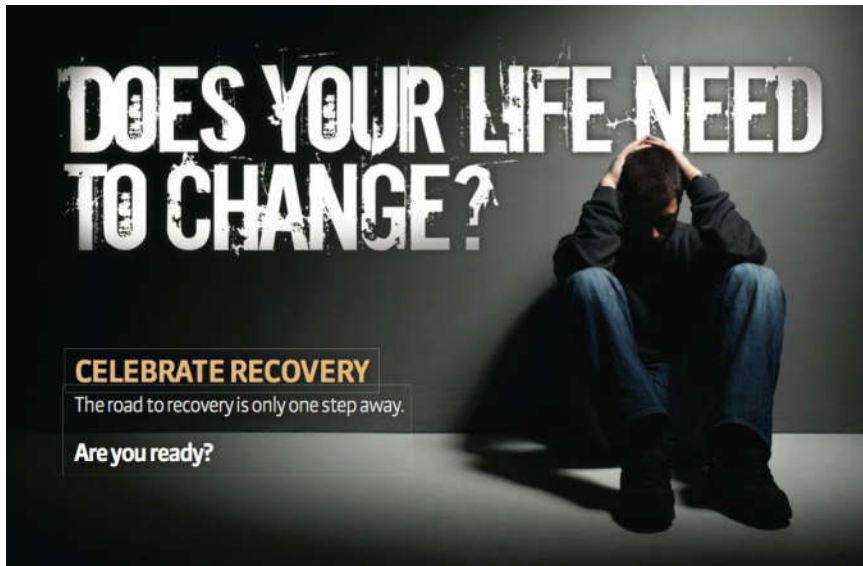
"Mortgage Principal Pay Down"
